Hello Carolyn, thanks for your interest. The address you provided is located along US 101 in the southbound direction. Based on previous planning work, potential sliver impacts were only identified in the northeast quadrant of the interchange along US 101 in the northbound direction. At this time, we do not anticipate any impacts to that property, South Amphlett Boulevard, or the adjacent soundwall. However, the current phase of the project will include additional surveys to more accurately define needed property to reduce the previously identified property impacts.
