# Program Overview

- **3% of Measure A Program**
- **Purpose of program is to fund specific capital projects to encourage and improve walking and bicycling conditions**
- **2004 Transportation Expenditure Plan includes a list of bikeways and overcrossings but other projects can be considered**



# Project Selection Process

## TA Strategic Plan calls for:

- Funding considerations made through a Call for Projects
- Projects reviewed based on a set of evaluation criteria
- Funding recommendations anchored to the evaluation criteria
- Board approves programming and allocation of funds



# Measure A Programming History

- **Programmed & Allocated Funds**

First cycle, July 2011	\$4.5 million
Second cycle, April 2014	\$5.8 million
<u>Special circumstances</u>	<u>\$0.7 million</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$11.0 million</b>



# Program Information

- **Measure A funded projects**

First cycle: 16 projects

Second cycle: 11 projects

Special circumstances: 2 projects

Total 29 projects

- **Project Status**

- 9 projects scope-of-work completed

- 20 projects ongoing

- 6 more projects complete by 6/30/15

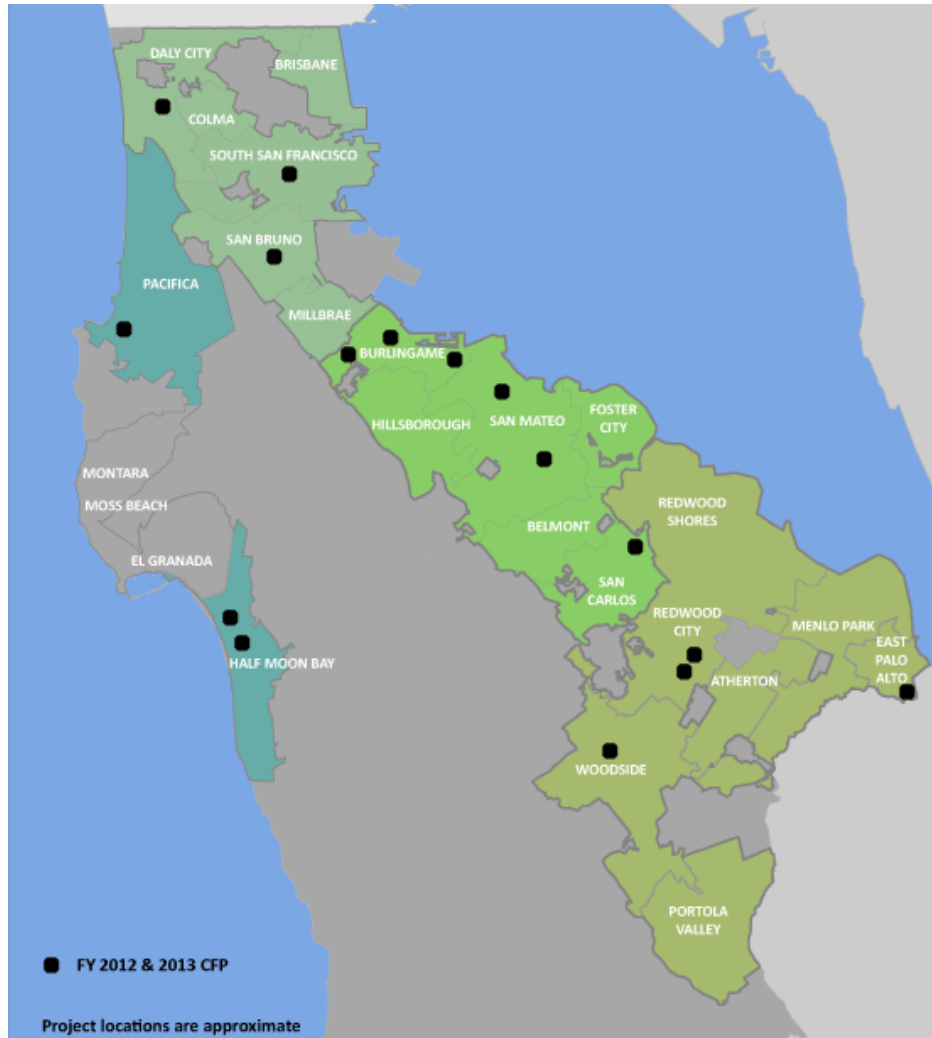
- **Project type**

<b>Pedestrian &amp; bicycle</b>	<b>22 projects</b>
<b>Bicycle only</b>	<b>5 projects</b>
<b>Pedestrian only</b>	<b>2 projects</b>
- **Measure A funded phase of work**

<b>Pre-construction only</b>	<b>7 projects</b>
<b>Full implementation</b>	<b>22 projects</b>



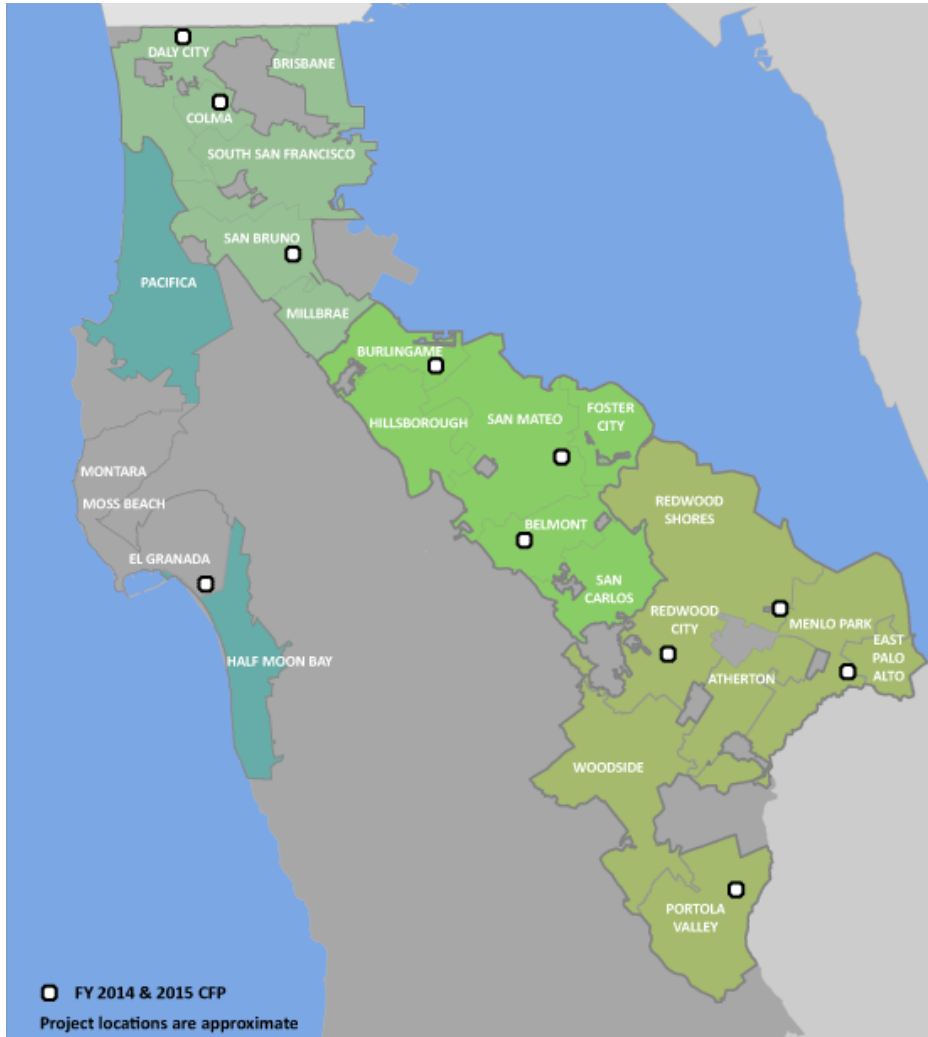
# First Cycle Projects (FY 2012 & 2013)





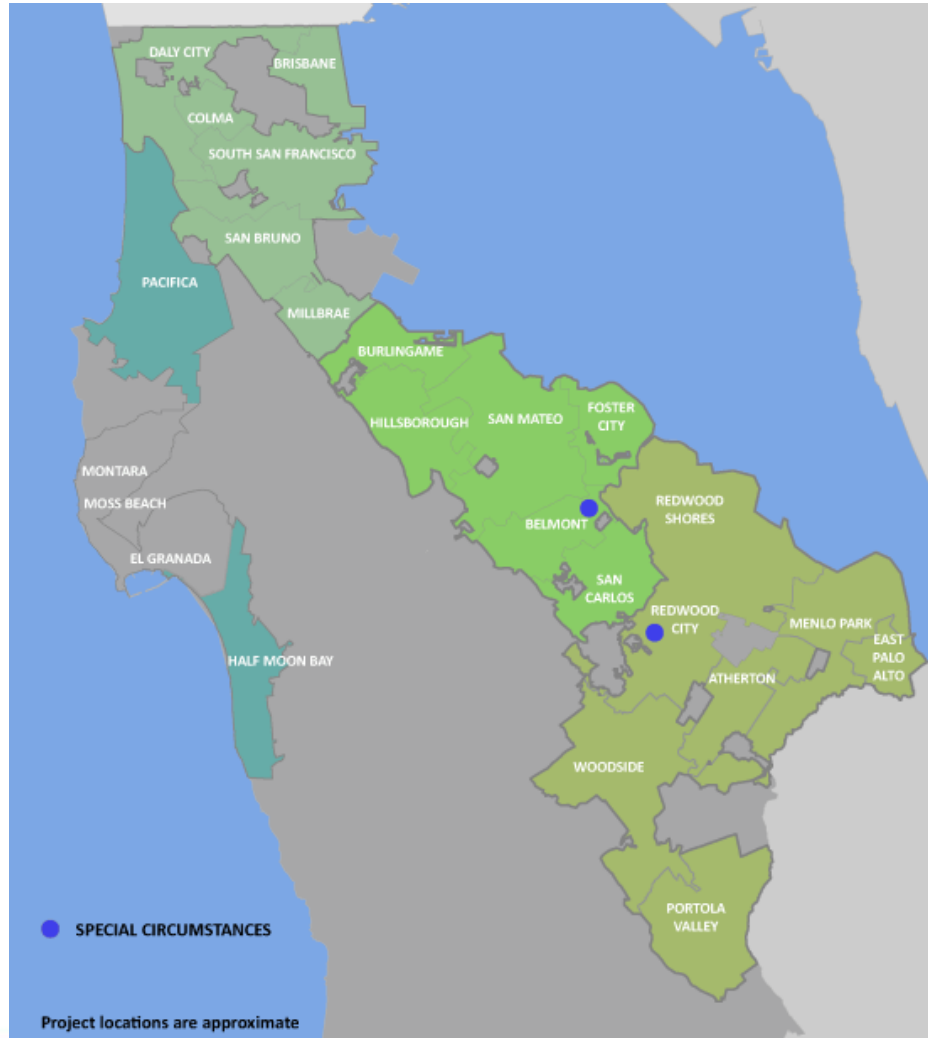


# Second Cycle Projects (FY2014 & 2015)



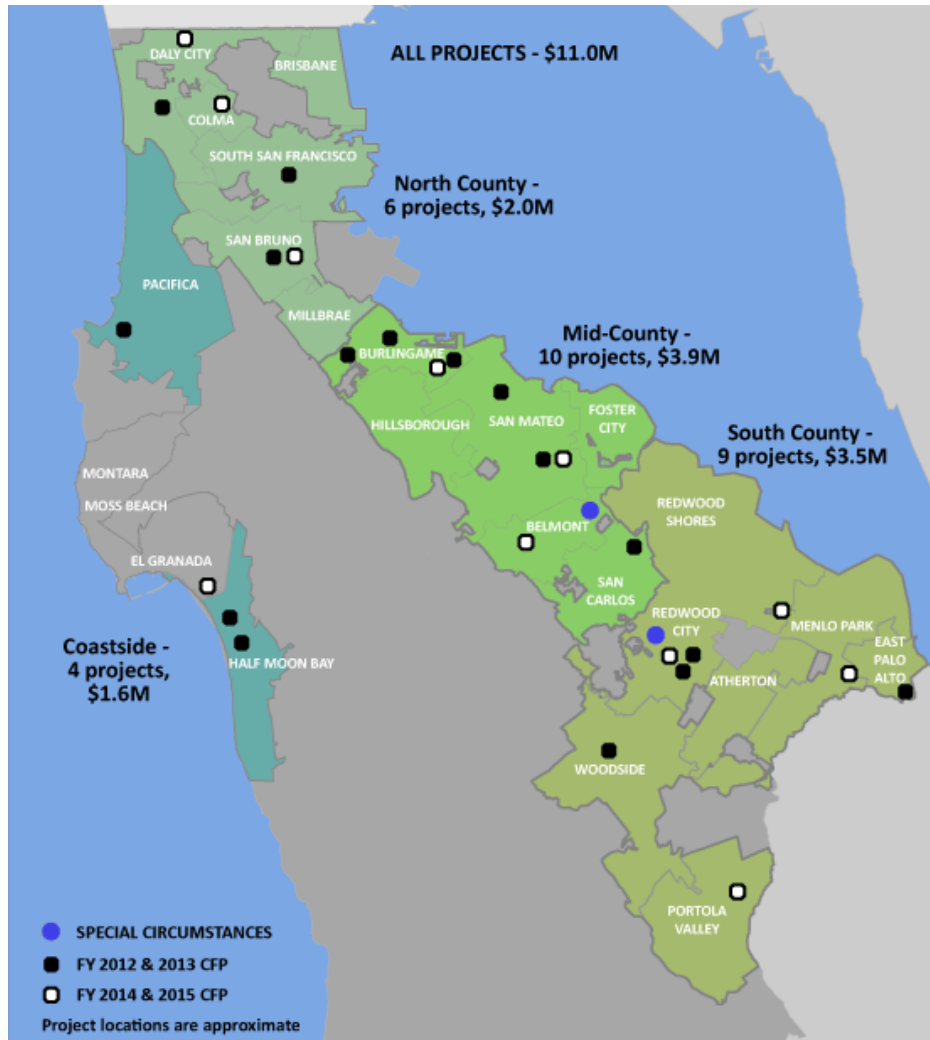

# Funded Project Types

- **Pedestrian/bicycle trails (Class I)**
  - Naomi Patridge trail
- **Bicycle striping/signing (Class II/III)**
  - Numerous projects with bike lanes/routes
- **Traffic calming/crossing upgrades**
  - Lake Merced Blvd. in-pavement crosswalk
  - California Drive roundabout
- **Pedestrian/bicycle overcrossings**
  - 101/Ralston pedestrian bicycle overcrossing

# Next Steps from Strategic Plan

- **Align Measure A funding calls to coincide with regional, state and federal funding programs**
- **Develop a CIP for long-term planning of large complex capital projects, such as overcrossings**
- **Explore and develop performance metrics to determine if the program and projects are meeting Measure A goals**
